About Us

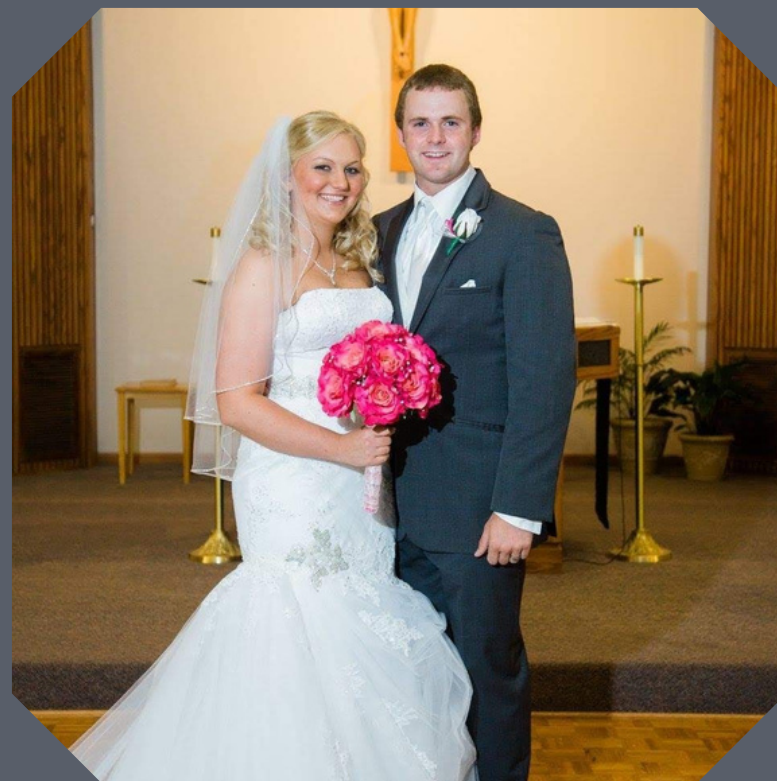

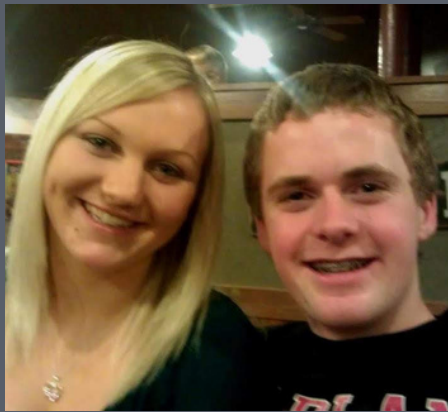




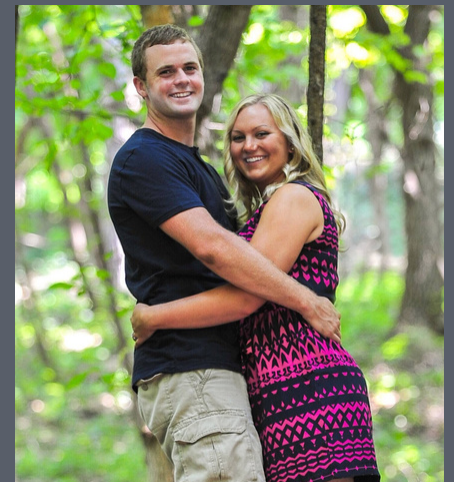
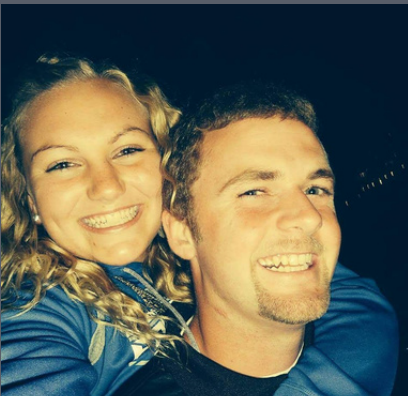
We met in high school and started dating in 2011 after our sisters set us up as prom dates our junior year. We stayed together long distance throughout college and got married in 2016.

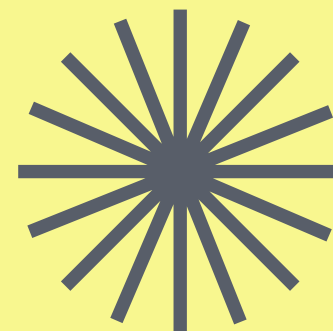

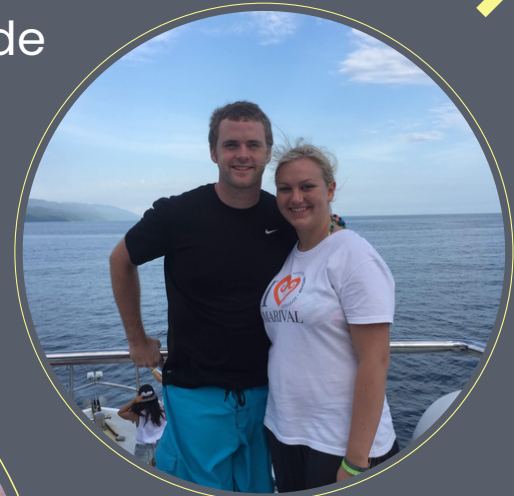

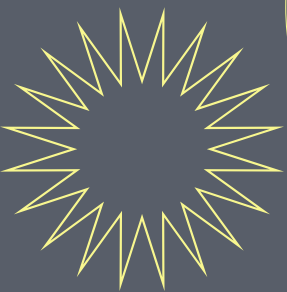
